

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN**

**DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE  
COLLEGE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES  
NATIONAL CHENGCHI UNIVERSITY  
AND  
FACULTY OF LAW, GRADUATE SCHOOL OF LAW,  
KEIO UNIVERSITY, JAPAN**

Department of Political Science, College of Social Sciences, National Chengchi University and Faculty of Law, Graduate School of Law, Keio University, wishing to promote cooperation between the two institutions in education and in academic research, agree to the following:

- a. to develop joint research activities;
- b. to invite each other to participate in seminars and conferences organized by the respective institutions;
- c. to support mutual visits by faculty members;
- d. to exchange undergraduate students, graduate students and researchers;
- e. to explore collaboration in education; and
- f. to exchange academic information in the form of publications, instructional materials and other results of teaching and research.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this cooperation agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity.

As both partners are aware of existing restrictions in their respective budgets, they will, as a rule, not enter into financial commitments that reach beyond such limits for any item of this cooperation. Therefore, financial aspects shall also be regulated on a case-by-case basis in separate signed writings.

Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

This cooperation agreement shall become effective upon signing by the representatives of both universities and will remain valid for a period of five years. The agreement is subject to review, and may be terminated by either Department of Political Science, College of Social Sciences, National Chengchi University or Faculty of Law, Graduate School of Law, Keio University by written notice signed by the presiding officer of the notifying party. To be effective, the notice of termination must be received by the other party twelve months before the proposed date of termination.


