Between

**DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE
NATIONAL CHENGCHI UNIVERSITY**

And

**DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS
KOREA UNIVERSITY**

AGREEMENT FOR JOINT WORKSHOP

THIS AGREEMENT is made on X May 2026 (“Effective Date”)

BETWEEN:

- (1) **NATIONAL CHENGCHI UNIVERSITY**, having its principal address at No. 64, Sec. 2, Zhinan Rd., Wenshan District, Taipei City 11605, Taiwan (R.O.C), acting through its **DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE (“NCCU”)**
- (2) **KOREA UNIVERSITY**, having its principal address at 145 Anam-ro, Seongbuk-gu, Seoul 02841, South Korea, acting through its **DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS (“KU”)**

1. PURPOSE

The objective of this Agreement is to establish a joint academic workshop program (“**Joint Workshop**”) between NCCU and KU in order to promote academic exchange and strengthen institutional cooperation between the two departments.

2. FORMAT

- 2.1 The Joint Workshop shall be organized as a student-centered academic exchange program, with a focus on research presentation and scholarly discussion.
- 2.2 The Joint Workshop may include paper presentations and related academic activities as agreed by the Parties.

3. PARTICIPATION

- 3.1 Each university may determine the number of participants at its own discretion.
- 3.2 Participation in the Joint Workshop shall, in principle, be flexible and not subject to a fixed quota, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.

4. SCHEDULE AND HOSTING ARRANGEMENTS

- 4.1 The Parties intend to organize the Joint Workshop on a regular basis, in principle, once every academic semester.
- 4.2 In principle:
 - (a) NCCU shall visit KU during the Spring semester; and
 - (b) KU shall visit NCCU during the Fall semester.
- 4.3 The specific schedule, venue, and program of each Joint Workshop shall be determined by mutual consultation in advance.

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 5.1 Each visiting university shall bear the travel and related expenses of its own participants, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.

5.2 The host university shall provide the venue and conference meal(s).

5.3 The host university may assist with local arrangements on a best-effort basis.

6. ADMINISTRATION

Each university shall designate a coordinator to facilitate communication and organization of the Joint Workshop.

7. TERM AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

7.1 This Agreement shall come into force upon the Effective Date and shall remain in effect for five (5) years ("Term"). Any modification shall be made in writing by mutual consent.

7.2 Either university may terminate this Agreement by giving written notice to the other university at least one (1) year prior to the intended date of termination.


7.3 This Agreement shall be extended for another Term upon expiry unless either university provides written notice of termination one (1) year prior to the expiry date.

7.4 Termination shall not affect any Joint Workshop already agreed upon prior to such termination, unless otherwise mutually agreed.

8. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes arising under or in connection with this Agreement which cannot be resolved by amicable discussions between the Parties shall be referred to the Presidents of the respective universities or their nominees for resolution, or may be submitted to some alternative dispute resolution mechanism as may be agreed in writing between the Parties.

Both universities jointly agree to the terms of this Agreement as set out above.
